



Common Types of Reiki

There many different Reiki styles that extend beyond the traditional Usui Reiki. Each style of Reiki has it's own philosophies, symbols, and process of attunement. All Reiki styles follow the fundamental belief in a universal energy that helps emotional, mental, spiritual, and physical healing.

Some suggest there are over 1000 styles of Reiki, with many sub-styles stemming from primary methods of Reiki. Some styles of Reiki have also developed based on geography and the relevant cultural belief's of each region including Tibet, India, and Egypt.

Below are some more popular styles of Reiki that have developed over time. Usui Reiki is listed first as the primary method of Reiki and the remaining styles are listed alphabetically with no preference given to reported efficacy.
